- o Mike Hardaway is continuing to fulfill Upgrade role until end of Feb when USAC will take over
- o LA revenue from USAC has seen steady decline over last 10 yrs; 2019 we received \$28,000
- o Lower subsidy for number of racers caused by collapsing brackets into broader buckets for a single level of payout

New USAC LA agreement update

- Possible to gain maximum of \$15,000 total for NCNCA in 2020 from USAC
- New agreement will centralize Permit Coordinator and Upgrade Coordinator (formerly Mike Hardaway)
- Permit Coordinator Approval has been quick, but the quality of review was questionable
 - San Bruno was canceled since USAC took longer to negotiate insurance; overall timelines from USAC have not favored our Jan 1 season start
- Upgrade Coordinator 2 months lag time in USAC taking over responsibilities
 - Mike Hardaway is continuing to fulfill Upgrade role until end of Feb when USAC says it is able to take over
 - Emergency Motion to continue to pay Mike for those 2 mo of work (Erik), Second (Rikke)
 - All in favor:

 - Motion carries, continue to pay Mike for 2 mo of work
 - Apply to USAC to reimburse those fees in the future?
