It was great that the NCNCA was able to pull off 20+ road races in 2021 even during the uncertain times that were presented to us with Covid. I am encouraged to see there are more than 60 event days with Race Clinics, New Official Clinics, and races on the 2022 road race calendar. Back for 2022 is the San Bruno Hill Climb. I believe the signs of recovery in the sport of cycling are hopeful and I suspect that we will see growth in the unique riders/per day over 2019 numbers.

Scheduling:

63 event days on the calendar San Bruno Hill Climb back in 2022 Early Birds working with two different possible courses

Into the Lions Den (Methods to Winning) people looking at possibility of having a State of California championship omnium (SCNCA and NCNCA). Is there interest? NCNCA can't pay for it by itself.... Methods to Winning group? Andrea to follow up.

Competition:

We need to decide if we are going to pursue changing age brackets for Master's Men immediately or put off until 2023. San Bruno needs to get their flyers put together.

I would like to discuss the possibility of 35+1/2/3, 40+1/2/3, 50+1/2/3, 60+1/2/3/4+ as it will represent the age range of today's brackets with breaking up and reforming the packs a bit differently than today. It also does not add additional categories to what exists today. It should also make it clear if the 35+1/2/3 should continue to exist.

Proposal (Leibold, Camacho): Change BAR groups to 30+1/2/3, 40+1/2/3, 50+1/2/3, 60+1/2/3/4+, with the 30+1/2/3 not expected to be at every race. Numbers/categories from 2020:
