May 18, 2008

Reno, NV

7.64 miles, 2126' elevation gain, 5.3% average grade. Course record: 29:25 (Bobby Julich)

Race #2: 6 Mile Canyon

June 29, 2008

Virginia City, NV

5.82 miles, 1642' elevation gain, 5.3% average grade. No official course record yet.

Race #4: Kingsbury Grade

September 7, 2008

Minden, NV

7.9 miles, 2550' elevation gain, 6.1% average grade. Course record: 38:46 (Aaron Baker)

Parking and registration To Be Announced. Start at corner of Foothill Rd. and Kingsbury Grade.

Registration: Registration for each event is day-of (no late fees, no field limits). Fill out a USA Cycling release form and bring to each race (http://www.usacycling.org/forms/rider_release.pdf).

Entry fee for each race is \$20. USCF License required. One-day licenses available.

Registration opens at 7:00 a.m. and closes at 8:45 a.m. **First rider off at 9:00 a.m.**

Riders will be given start times at registration, and will be started in order of registration.

Categories: Open Men Open Women Juniors (under 18)
Master Men (35+) Master Women (35+)

Prizes: This is a four-race series. **Riders must race all four events to qualify for overall prizes.** Overall placing will be determined by cumulative time for the four events.

Individual Event Prizes: The top 3 in each category (Open Men, Open Women, Master Men, Master Women) and the top Junior win Sierra Nevada Hill Climb TT Series pint glasses.

Series Overall Prizes: The top 3 overall in each category will receive cash and merchandise. Cash prize amounts will be determined based on number of entries (min. \$30/20/10 per category).

Open Men overall winner and Junior overall winner will also receive Mavic Wheelsets!
