President's Report (Kerrigan): New contract for NCNCA with USAC. Now no need to deny listings on website, etc for non USAC events. No 990 tax forms need to be posted on website. No every page disclaimer statement from USAC, only on homepage. We still need to send them 990's. ---2008 USAC membership was about 1% above 2007 in NCNCA area. New surcharges: \$1 more for USAC insurance (now total \$3 per rider per day). ---New rule: Promoters must include on race ad this note: Listed entry fee for online does not include on-line fees. ---IRS mileage rate going down to 50 cents per mile for 2009.

Vice President (Meilahn): Greg Van den Dries is now the Junior Points Series coordinator. ---We have an interest in making training rides safer. Let's start with a link and notes on the website on safety.
