President (Kerrigan):

- NCNCA 2009 Scheduling Meeting Moved to 1st Monday in November (Nov 3, 2008). Tom Simpson to arrange meeting place? -- due to several USAC and USCF meetings in Colorado Springs the second weekend which will involve several key players at the Scheduling meeting.

Discussion: Results chip systems for finishes: Either passive chip systems or active transponder system. Active system better, but costs more, but can be done by local officials after training. Will this sort of

results go USAC wide? Should it be NorCal wide?. Shall we pick some early local races to test systems for ourselves?. Motion passed: Contact a transponder system vendor to see what it will cost to do demonstration finish system at Snelling Road race Feb 2009. NCNCA to subsidize or cover the costs depending on the results of the contact. Further discussion at October meeting.

- Results: for upcoming races, Velo Promo will institute the following policy. As in USAF rules, results are final 15 minutes after the posting race day at the site. After posting on Velo Promo website, there will be only 48 hours to check for VP's mistakes only. (transcription errors, Official-approved changes failing to get in on race day, etc). No other changes will be made. After that, results are final
