Update on standard committee meeting schedule - Gabby

### Officials Committee (Matt)

New officials online class started with 28 candidates. Hoping to attend Early Bird when it happens. 6 races don't yet have a CR and rest are scheduled. Some candidates are looking to intern at races. Scoring laptops ordered and tested.

#### Scheduling / Promoters Committee (Gabby)

Webmaster / Alec gave Jason permission to update NCNCA.org with calendar updates.

- All events on bikereg and permits on USAC have links on the calendar.
- Strava course segment was added as a page element. Promoters have been asked to provide a segment link on the scheduling spreadsheet. Many of the upcoming races now have Strava segment links on NCNCA.org.

**ACTION (Melissa, Gabby, Jason)**: Meet and discuss access to to edit NCNCA.org and content pieces to update on the website.

### Competition / Championships Committee

Review and approve 2023 BAR/BAT rules / guidelines (here). 2023 changes include:

- Added or changed to the 2023 rules:
  - Updated BAR/BAT categories to increase racing interest and participation in underrepresented categories. Eliminated Men's M123 30+ & M3/4 50+ categories and changed M123 40+ 123 to M123 35+.
  - Premier series events will earn double points (maximum 15 places, based on field size as shown above).
  - Combined E3 & E4 Spring and Summer competitions into a season-long competition for simplicity and to match the other competitions.
  - Include criterium and road race district masters championship points into respective BAR/BAT competition points (e.g. 35-39, 40-44, 45-49 would roll up into 35+ 123 competition. 50-54, 55-59 would roll up into 50+ 123, etc.).
  - Events permitted outside USAC must be voted on and agreed by the

- board to be included in BAR/BAT, otherwise the event will not be eligible for the competition. The promoter must pay NCNCA the current year rider day rate that NCNCA would have received from USAC. This payment must be made within 30-days after the event.
- After November 1st, promoters who add a race on the same date as an existing race on the calendar must contact and discuss the event with the existing race promoter. If an agreement cannot be reached for the new event (ie adjustment of fields/categories or dates), then the new race will not be eligible for BAR/BAT points. The new race promoter may appeal the rule to the NCNCA BoD. (revised existing language)
- Removed to simplify the rules:
  - Field additions made less than two weeks prior to an event will render the field ineligible for BAR/BAT due to the late date of the change. An appeal can be made to the NCNCA Board for an exception.

Update on 2023 District Championship kit vendor/sponsor. Matt waiting to hear back from vendors.

SCNCA voted down doing a state championship.
